Town Hall Meeting

On Wednesday, July 15, 2009 from 7pm to 9pm, Supervisor Mike May, Chairman Corey Stewart and county planning and transportation staff will host a community meeting to update residents as to the long range land use and transportation updates to the Prince William County Comprehensive Plan. This is a great opportunity to learn about the update and ask questions. Supervisor May will also present the final report for the Occoquan District Visioning project, which has taken place over the last several months with the participation and support of numerous Occoquan District citizens. Copies of the final report will be available for interested residents.

I-95 Widening Project

We recently received some good news from VDOT regarding the I-95 widening project. The additional northbound lane between Route 1 and the Fairfax County Parkway is expected to open

by the end of the year. In addition, the project seems to be progressing well with a tentative completion date for the entire project (from the Fairfax County Parkway to Route 123 for both northbound and southbound lanes) of Fall of 2011.

In addition, the following information may be useful:

- The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers and the Virginia Marine Resources Commission authorized VDOT to work in the Occoquan River beginning July 1. VDOT has coordinated this work with U.S. Coast Guard to ensure boater safety during construction.
- This river work will occur over the next two years and focus on building bridge supports and piers to carry the new north and southbound I-95 lanes across the Occoquan Bridge.
- Boaters and water traffic will see five to six barges carrying equipment and material to perform this work during the July, 2009 through February, 2010 timeframe.

This is actually great news because more bridge and road materials being transported by barge will mean less of it will have to be transported by trucks on I-95. This will help ensure better safety and smoother traffic flow for our commuters.

Old Bridge Sidewalk Project Update

The sidewalk project is moving along. County transportation staff informed me earlier this spring that the stumps would be removed by July 1, but due to delays with supplies and weather the county is now hoping to remove the stumps as utility lines are installed along the Old Bridge corridor. We are hoping that the stump removal will be complete in about 30 days, with the entire project completed within about 90 days. At that time, we will take a look to see if we can supplement the area with additional trees and vegetation.

Old Bridge S-Curve Project Update

You many have noticed construction recently along Old Bridge Road between Colby Drive and Forest Hill Road, also know as the S-Curve. VDOT has completed the road construction portion of the project, which is intended to make the roadway safer for motorists. Additional guardrail is scheduled to be installed in the next few weeks, which will be another important safety enhancement.
